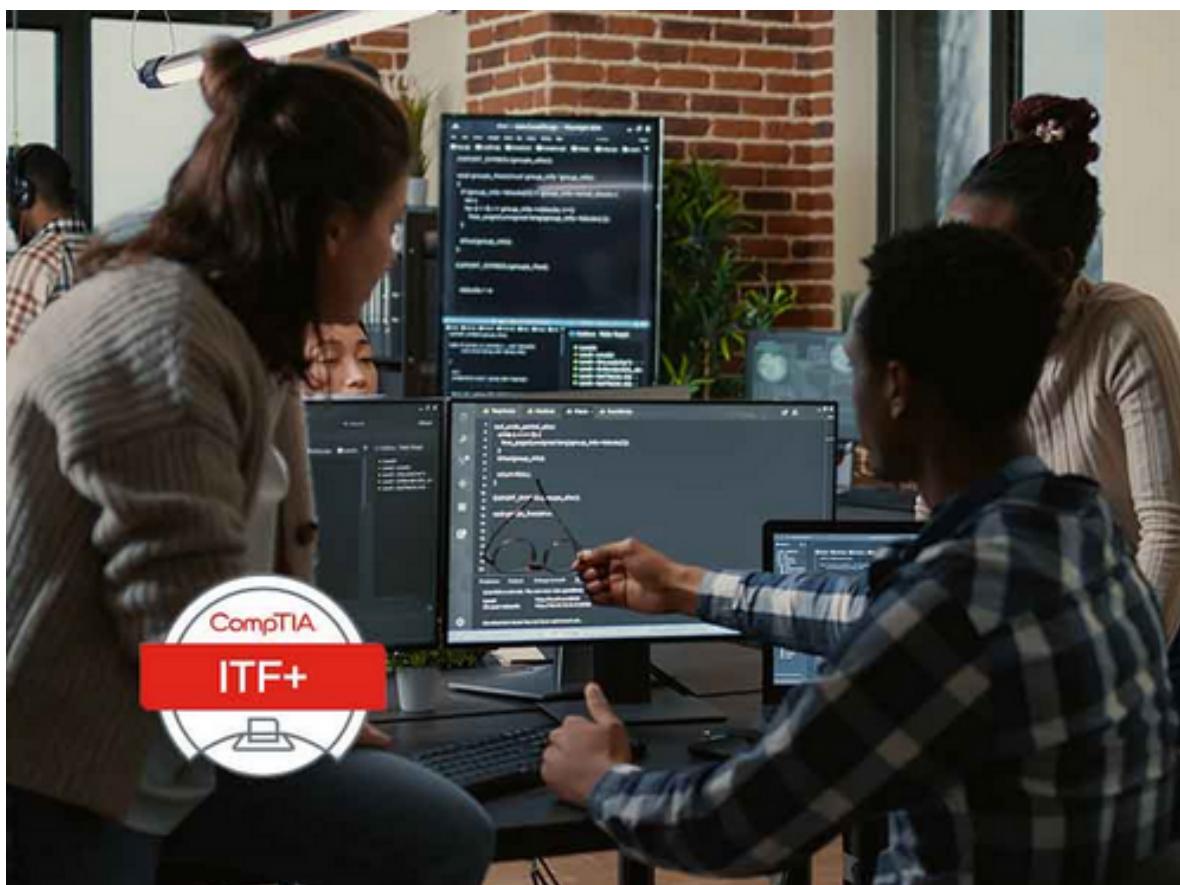

About This Course:

QuickStart's CompTIA IT Fundamentals course caters to IT Career Pathway students. With minimal prerequisites, participants are expected to possess basic digital skills. Students learn fundamental skills needed in the IT industry. Areas of IT covered include hardware, software, programming, security, software development,

database fundamentals, and infrastructure.

This course will prepare you to take the FC0-U61 exam to obtain the IT Fundamentals+ certification and help you to learn some of the basic principles and techniques of providing PC, mobile, applications, and network support. This course covers all IT fundamentals, creating a broader understanding and a helpful on-ramp to tech career pathways

Completing this course will also help students acquire the knowledge and skills to set up and use a computer at home securely and keep it in good working order and to provide informal support for PCs and simple computer networks in a small business.

Course Objectives:

- **IT Concepts and Terminology:** Notational systems, computing basics and the value of data and troubleshooting
- **Infrastructure:** Set up and install common peripheral devices to a laptop/PC or secure a basic wireless network
- **Applications and Software:** Applications software, the various components of an operating system and the purpose of methods of application architecture
- **Software Development:** Programming language categories, logic, and the purpose of programming concepts
- **Database Fundamentals:** Database concepts, structures, and purpose, as well as methods used to interface
- **Security:** Confidentiality, integrity and availability concerns of secure devices and best practice methods

- Students considering a career in IT.
- Professionals working in fields that require a broad understanding of IT.
- Marketing, sales and operations staff in IT-based organizations.

- CompTIA IT Fundamentals+ is aimed at those considering a career in IT and computer-related fields. There are no prerequisites for you to meet to successfully start this course, though having a High School Diploma or GED is strongly encouraged.
