Moreover, it also gives extensive examples to work with information provisioning and protection technologies such as Dynamic Access Control (DAC), and Web Application Proxy integration with AD FS and Workplace Join.

This course goes one step further by moving to practical exercises as compared to just theoretical knowledge. Along with tutorials this course includes practical exercises to practice the configuration of advanced Windows Server 2012, including Windows Server 2012 R and services in this Microsoft Official Course.

Primarily, this course has been designed specifically to prepare all participants for the Microsoft Certified Solutions Associate (MCSA): Exam 411: Administering Windows Server 2012 and ensure that they clear it with flying colors.
