About this course:

We get familiar with a real-world way to deal with setting up a task in JIRA with this course. As the course title indicates, this isn't a model task, but instead, it's a real-world task that is utilized consistently. We'll begin by recovering the story for the task so we'll realize what the requirements are. At that point we'll begin constructing the task, modifying JIRA to satisfy our needs. Along the route, we'll find out about issues, projects, issue types, screens, plans, work processes, time following and considerably more.
